Sub: INCOIS-IMD Joint Bulletin - Ocean State Forecast associated with Deep Depression over northwest Bay of Bengal and close to West Bengal coast

The Deep Depression over northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining areas of West Bengal North Odisha coasts moved slowly west-northwestwards with the speed of 7 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centred at 1730 hrs IST of today, the 27th July 2026, over northwest Bay of Bengal close to West Bengal coast near latitude 21.6°N and longitude 87.7°E, about 20 km east of Digha (West Bengal), 20 km south-southwest of Contai, 40 km west of Sagar Island (West Bengal), 60 km southwest of Haldia (West Bengal), 80 km east of

Balasore (Odisha) and 120 km southwest of Canning (West Bengal). It is very likely to move nearly west-northwestwards and cross West Bengal-North Odisha coasts close to east of Digha and west of Haldia by early morning of tomorrow, the 28th July 2026.

High Wave/Ocean State Alert/Warning for Odisha & West Bengal:

West Bengal: High waves in the range of 2.4 – 3.0 meters are forecasted during 22:30 hours on 27-07-2026 to 05:30 hours on 28-07-2026 along the coast of West Bengal between Digha to Bakkhali. Surface Current speeds vary between 0.35 - 0.89 m/sec.

Odisha: High waves in the range of 1.9 – 2.8 meters are forecasted during 22:30 hours on 27-07-2026 to 05:30 hours on 28-07-2026 along the coast off Odisha from Gopalpur to Chandipur. Surface Current speeds vary between 0.5 - 0.88 m/sec.

Ocean state forecast - Offshore (Around the system):

High waves in the range of 3.0 – 3.5 meters are predicted from 22:30 hours on 27-07-2026 to 05:30 hours on 28-07-2026 around the system (latitude 21.6°N and longitude 87.71°E, about 20 km east of Digha (West Bengal)). Surface Current speeds vary between 60 - 105 cm/sec.

Warnings:

Fishermen Warnings:

- Fishermen are advised not to venture into northwest Bay of Bengal and along & off Odisha, West Bengal & north Andhra Pradesh coasts till morning of 29th July.
- Fishermen are advised not to venture into central and northeast Bay of Bengal during till 28th July.

Wind Warnings:

- Squally winds with speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph is likely to prevail over Northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining Odisha-West Bengal-north Andhra Pradesh coasts till morning of 28th July and decrease gradually thereafter.
- Squally winds with speed reaching 40-50 gusting to 60 kmph are likely to prevail over central and northeast Bay of Bengal during 27th - 28th July.

Rainfall Warning:

- **Odisha:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at a few places and very heavy to extremely heavy rainfall (≥ 21 cm) at isolated places on 27th July and heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 28th July.
- **Gangetic West Bengal:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 27th and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 28th July.

Impact Expected and Action Suggested due to heavy rainfall and squally winds

Impact expected:

- ❖ Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks. Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ❖ Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds and rain.
- ❖ Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- ❖ Loose objects may fly.
- ❖ Small ships, trawlers and boats may be affected.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- ❖ There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips, water logging, inundation and flooding over low lying areas.
- ❖ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Helicopter services may get affected.

Action Suggested

- ❖ People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.
- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- ❖ Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- ❖ Onshore and offshore activities to be judiciously regulated.
- ❖ Helicopter services to be regulated.
